Scope of Work - Building and Construction

The scope of work for the industry needs to be relevant to residential works, commercial developments and civil construction projects such as: residential and commercial building construction; civil infrastructure.

- renovations and extensions of residential and commercial buildings
- installation services for interiors of residential and commercial buildings and the associated trades: electrical, plumbing, flooring etc
- land development and site preparation for the purpose of construction
- work for a designated Major Project including applications of heavy and civil engineering used in the construction of infrastructure and this must form the majority of their work to be considered substantially engaged within the industry.
